The City of Toledo (Population 2,276) is accepting applications for the anticipated opening of a full-time police officer in the fall of 2021.

The Toledo Police Department consists of six full-time and three reserve police officers. Full-time officers work 12-hour shifts with every other weekend off. The starting hourly wage for an ILEA certified full-time officer is \$20.91. The starting hourly wage for a non-certified full-time officer is \$19.23 with a raise to \$20.19 after completion of the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy. All minimum ILEA standards apply. ILEA certified officers are preferred. The wage for ILEA full-time certified officers is negotiable based on years of service and experience.

Applications will be accepted until Friday, June 11, 2021 at 5 PM CST. Please request an application packet by calling 641-484-3013, or by emailing Chief Nathan Shepard at pdchief@toledoia.gov.

All applicants must pass a background investigation before testing or an interview is offered. Non-certified applicants must pass the POST and ILEA Physical Agility Tests to be considered for an interview. ILEA certified officers will not be required to take the POST or Physical Agility tests. Transfer of POST and MMPI scores will be accepted if done within the last year. Out of state certified applicants will be required to pass certification through examination in Iowa.

Applicants required to test and/or considered for an interview will be contacted directly to set up a date and time.
